Once you have completed this form please email it to <u>competition@physicspartners.com</u>, along with the Student Consent forms and Parent/Guadian consent forms. The video must be uploaded to <u>WeTransfer</u> and sent to <u>competition@physicspartners.com</u>, noting your name and your school's name.

As you will have read, the top ten shortlisted teams will be invited to attend the prize winner's event at Merton College, Oxford University on 8 and 9 April 2024, where the overall winner will be announced. At least one teacher from your school/college will need to accompany the team on this overnight trip, where they will also have a tour of the Department of Physics. Amazon vouchers will be awarded as prizes to all the shortlisted teams who attend the event at Oxford, and your school/college will receive £1000 to spend on physics equipment.

If your team are announced as the overall winning then your school/college will be given the opportunity to arrange a trip for the winning team to CERN, Switzerland, home of the Large Hadron Collider. The trip is expected to take place at a convenient time during July/August 2024 and a teacher/s from your school/college must accompany them.

Videos from the ten shortlisted teams may be used by partners running the competition: <u>Oxford</u> <u>University Department of Physics</u>, <u>Merton College</u>, and <u>Physics Partners</u>. This use may include, but is not limited to, sharing on College, University and Physics Partners websites and social media channels, publishing on YouTube, re-editing of material to appropriate formats, and creation of classroom resources around the videos. The students are asked not to provide their full names in the videos, and these will never be published alongside the videos.




